Patient: Mixed breed dog, 5 years old, medium size

Surgeon: Ciprian OBER, DVM, PhD, ResECVS

History: right forelimb lameness

**Physical exam:** grade 4 (of 5) lameness at left forelimb; carpal instability and moderate valgus during stance

**Requested imagistic:** radiographs (anteroposterior and mediolateral right carpus and elbow; also carpal stress radiographs)

Presumtive diagnosis (xrays exams required)

Chronic arthritis/instability of the right carpal joint

Therapeutic alternative if definitive diagnosis

Pancarpal arthrodesis (see below images

Aprox costs: 1800 ron

## Postoperative requirements:

Elisabethan colar for 2 weeks and stiches removal 10 days of antibiotics and pain killers 2 months of cage rest some patients require implant removal after 9 months

**Potential complications:** infections; wound dehiscents, 3<sup>rd</sup> metacarpal bone fracture with screw migration
